

Wrongful Death Suit Filed In Child Pool Electrocution

The family of a seven-year-old North Miami boy electrocuted in a backyard swimming pool has filed a wrongful death lawsuit.

The family of Calder Sloan, who was electrocuted April 13, 2014, is suing the company that made the pool light and a second company who serviced the pool.

The complaint claims the child was electrocuted because the lighting system manufactured by Pentair Water Pool and Spa, Inc., was faulty.

It also says the maintenance company that regularly serviced the pool, All Florida Pool and Spa Center, should have warned the family about the defects, since it provided cleaning and inspections of the pool.

The Sloans' story has resulted in thousands of people around the country getting their pools inspected and repaired.
